NEW TESTAMENT LESSON – 2 Corinthians 9

The Collection for Christians at Jerusalem Please have the gift ready!

9¹For as touching the ministering [offering] to the saints, it is superfluous [unnecessary] for me to write to you:

²For I know the forwardness [readiness] of your mind, for which I boast of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many [stirred up their zeal].

³Yet have I sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this behalf; that, as I said, ye may be ready:

⁴Lest haply if they of Macedonia come with me, and find you unprepared, we (that we say not, ye) should be ashamed in this same confident boasting.
