ST. LUKES PARISH HOUSE RENOVATIONS PROJECT

Worshippers and visitors frequently comment about the beauty of our church grounds and sanctuary. Our Rector, Wardens, Vestry and lay leaders assure that the Lord's house and grounds are respectfully maintained to always be a beautiful welcoming and worshipful environment.

On the other hand, due to its outdated appearance and need for numerous repairs, our Parish House is overdue to be upgraded. Aside from it being the church administrative center and offices of the Rector, Treasurer, and Administrative Assistant, it also supports these important functions:

- The parlor: for private pastoral counseling and/or small group meetings.
- The conference room: where church committees hold planning sessions.
- The kitchen: where staff and church groups refrigerate food, prepare meals, and clean-up—especially to support the Misinco Pavilion related events.
- The bathroom: its function requires no explanation.

The St. Luke's Men's Group (SLMG) and Women of St. Lukes (WSL) have agreed to jointly accomplish the <u>St. Luke's Parish House Renovation Project</u>. We shall address repairs, upgrades, and functional improvements to our Parish House. Labor will be performed by hiring professional vendors as needed and relying on capable SLMG and WSL volunteers whenever its appropriate.

Our Vestry has approved this project and cost projections show that all upgrades could be accomplished for *under \$10,000*. (COST TABLES, on the back).

How is the "Parish House Renovation Project" to be funded?

The entire project shall be funded through a combination of parishioner donations and from Vestry approved St. Luke's Church treasury funds.
