

**MINUTES**  
**Parish Church of St. Luke, Blue Ridge, Georgia, Inc.**  
**Vestry Meeting**  
**July 24, 2022**

The Vestry of the Parish Church of St. Luke, Blue Ridge, Georgia, Inc., held its regular meeting Sunday, July 24, 2022, in the Yellow Room.

Members present were: The Rev. Victor H. Morgan, Rector; Al Cash, Senior Warden; Jim Noblett, Junior Warden; Bob Bradley; William Trotter; Neil McDonald; D.J. Fulton, treasurer; Lauren Burgreen and Jennifer Higdon. Deacon William A. "Tony" McConnell, vestry clerk, was absent (excused).

The Rector called the meeting to order at 11:28 a.m. with a prayer.

Minutes from June meeting were reviewed. Lauren Burgreen moved the minutes be approved as presented; Neil McDonald seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous vote.

Treasurer D. J. Fulton presented the financial report. Responding to a question from Senior Warden Al Cash concerning collections, Fulton reported that the church has a year-to-date surplus in the general fund of roughly \$15,000. This surplus was generated in January. In subsequent months, collections have broken even with expenses. Al Cash moved that financial report be accepted as presented. Motion was seconded by Lauren Burgreen, and approved by unanimous vote.

Junior Warden Jim Noblett reported bids for the replacement of the parish house roof have been received from Steve Stacy and SE Roofing. An additional one from Mountain Top Roofing is being awaited.

In addition, a quote of \$1750 for replacing the antiquated fuse box in the Parish House with a 200-amp breaker panel has been received from Vic Palmieri. The quote includes parts and labor. Jim Noblett moved that the quote be accepted and Mr. Palmieri be engaged to perform the work, which is expected to take two days. Neil McDonald seconded the motion, which was approved by unanimous vote.

Neil McDonald reported that SLMG decided to hold the church's annual picnic on site in the pavilion. Dates were reviewed and Sunday, Sept. 25, 2022, was

identified as open. Neil McDonald moved that the event be held following a combined service, on Sunday, Sept. 25. Bob Bradley second the motion, which was approved by unanimous vote.

Neil McDonald, in a separate matter, reported that renovation of the parish house kitchen was on hold until the electric panel project was completed.

Vestry members concurred that the next vestry meeting will be held Sunday, Aug. 21.

The meeting adjourned at 12:12.
